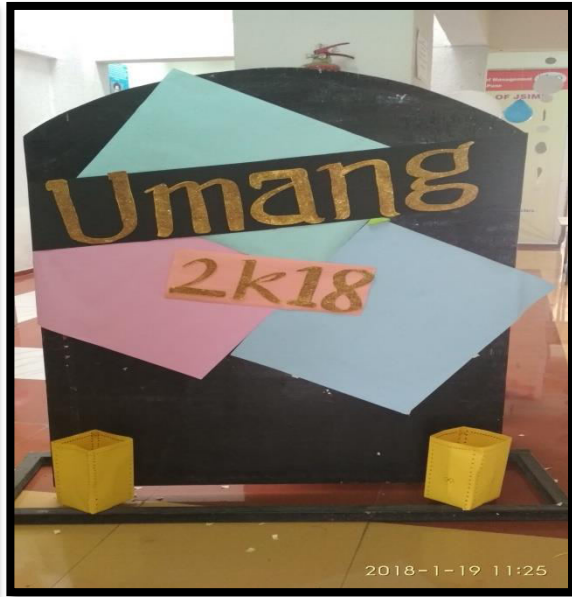

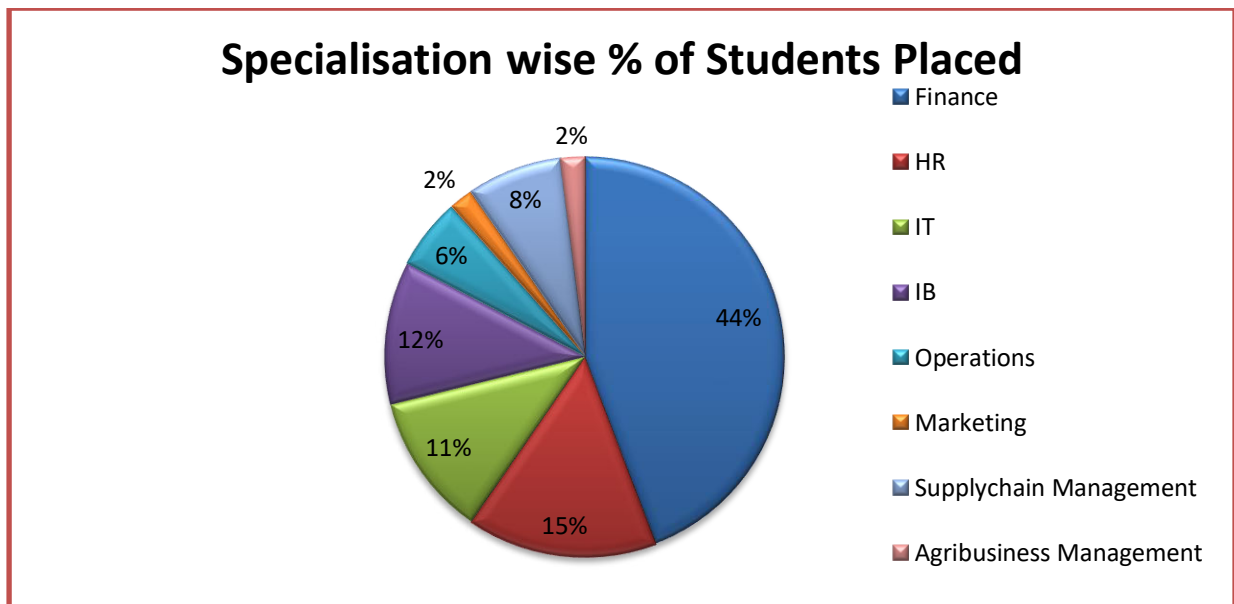
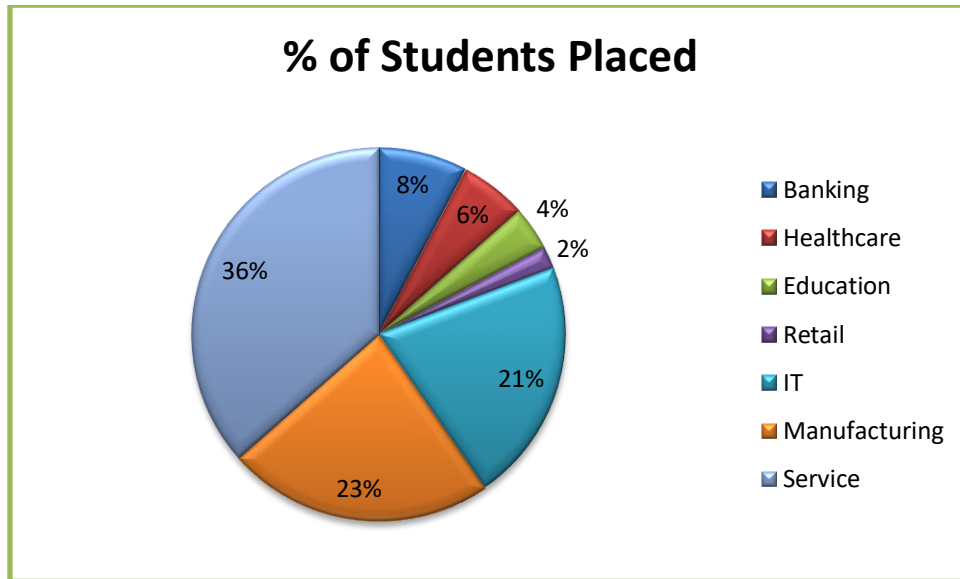


Youth day Celebration on 12/01/2018

Market Segmentation at Maruti Suzuki Ltd

The purpose of this activity was to teach the students the practical aspects of how market segmentation plays an important role while doing a purchase transaction. The market segmentation in marketing was taught in the classroom as per the SPPU syllabus. However to have a better understanding of the topic the students were divided into groups of 5 students per batch. The students were later sent to dealer of Maruti Suzuki to study the concept in detail. The students checked out the various market segmentation in which the consumer makes a purchase decision based on the income, class, demography, alternatives in the product, brand name, feasibility analysis of the product, pricing, after sales service, warranty/guarantee etc. These factors were considered based on interaction with the walk in customers. Detail analysis of the study was done and it was presented in the class room by these student groups.

However to have a better understanding of the topic the students were divided into groups of 4 students per batch. The students were later put up in groups to study the concept in detail. They had group discussions in classroom and came up with various solutions.

Instead of the faculty teaching a particular topic that day the student acted as teacher and taught the students wherein the faculty member of that particular subject was keen observer. The whole idea behind this exercise was to bring in the talent and skill combined with knowledge to be imparted to the students.

Flea Market

The purpose of this activity was to teach the students the practical aspects of how marketing is life blood of any organization. The student should understand the core concepts of marketing i.e. needs, wants, desires and demand. It was very important for the students to make them understand these core concepts which are the very foundation of marketing.

Accordingly the students were placed in groups of 3 per group and they were instructed to invest minimum capital and put up stalls. The students put up various stalls like panipuri, greet cards, mehendi, stationery items etc. They sold these products with the help of marketing concepts which was taught in the classroom. The students made good profit out of this sale.

Product Mix at Big Bazaar



The purpose of this activity was to teach the students the practical aspects of Product Mix. Product mix was taught in the classroom as per the SPPU syllabus. However to have a better understanding of the topic the students were divided into groups of 5 students per batch. The students were later sent to Big Bazaar mall to study the concept in detail. The students checked out different product mixes at the mall for all FMCG related products and interacted with the staff and walk in customers. They collected the data and returned to the institute. Later they presented the data in form of presentation in the class.
